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New signs for the Citizen Patrol and Multnomah Falls

The vehicle break-ins dropped significantly this month. A "car prowling" ring involving four suspects was disrupted near the end of last month. The suspects were involved in numerous break-ins throughout the entire metro area. The Citizen Patrol was able to link one of the suspects to a break-in and some of the other suspects were arrested at the zoo after breaking into cars there. We were also able to tie them to a significant theft that occurred last fall. So this is a big win for all of us. Despite this, we still get reports of suspicious persons looking inside vehicles and we've six break-ins this month.

The Citizen Patrol is in the process of receiving some grant money that will be useful in acquiring equipment for patrol members. An initial purchase was made to purchase the signs (top left). The Citizen Patrol will soon be hitting the street in areas where we receive a lot of traffic related complaints. Although they will not be able to write citations, they will use a radar to track the level of violations in an area. This information will be relayed to deputies who will be able to target their patrols more effectively. The larger sign shown in the middle will be placed in front of the Multnomah Falls Lodge crosswalk area (by the Forest Service volunteers) to remind tourists to remove valuables from their vehicles. A deputy was able to secure an ACTS grant (Alliance for Community Traffic Safety) that has allowed the purchase of 5 moving-radar units for our patrol cars. This will help deputies insure speed compliance. If you have a traffic safety concern in the Corbett area, feel free to contact Deputy Graziano (see below) so that we can target our patrols.

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
