We've had quite a few burglaries and thefts in Corbett this past month. There were a few theft incidents that weren't officially reported by the victims and they aren't listed on the crime log. Residents are remaining vigilant which is great when we have increased activity like this in the community. Please don't hesitate to call our Dispatch number if you see suspicious activity. We'd rather find that the suspicious activity is merely a legitimate delivery driver or a lost tourist truly asking for directions versus getting legitimate information a week later. So please continue to "trust your gut" and act on your instinct.

I generally only release suspect vehicle information when it appears highly likely. I have received other isolated reports of suspicious persons in other vehicles with very odd requests such as, "Do you know anyone that speaks sign language?" If you feel unsettled about the situation it's ok to not open the door. It's also ok to call our non-emergency# (503-823-3333) to let us know. It's nice for deputies to get a call such as this and then to be able to locate the person(s) and hopefully determine that they are "ok". It's good to settle everyone's nerves!

On 11/22/11 a semi truck hit the east end of the Stark Street Bridge (again). The truck apparently lurched and bounced hard as it hit the concrete barrier. A 3-foot section of the railing was bent and luckily there was no structural damage. Numerous driver's saw the incident occur. The truck driver pulled over at the west end of the bridge and the other motorists departed....without reporting the incident. The truck then departed too....without reporting the incident as is required when there is property damage. Luckily a Citizen Patrol member witnessed the incident and reported it. Although she didn't get a plate, her observations were enough to track down the driver who had apparently gone to Mexico. With the cooperation of the Washington Dept. of Transportation, the truck driver, his passenger and their insurance company were identified.

We've finally initiated the purchase of our surveillance camera with funds donated to the Citizen Patrol. This camera will help us with our investigations of various issues in the Corbett area. We are anxiously awaiting its arrival for it first mission! We are also in the process of using the remaining donations to work with the Springdale Job Corps and our county Radio Shop in establishing a VHF radio network among several Corbett entities and the Citizen Patrol. The network will allow for Citizen Patrollers to use radios on their patrols. It will also help us with communication in the event of a disaster. Again, we thank the following for their donations: Crown Point Refuse (\$1000), Big Bear Market (\$1000), Friends of Multnomah Falls (\$500), Wal-Mart (\$500) and the Horseless Carriage Society

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
