



I-84 BRIDGE DECK IMPROVEMENTS

July 2013

Overview

A contractor for the Oregon Department of Transportation will replace the driving surface on two bridges on Interstate 84 in the Dodson and Warrendale area. The joints will also be replaced on these bridges.

The bridges are at Dodson both east and westbound, milepost 35. This is the second phase of a four-bridge replacement project.

Project Timeline

Work on the bridges at Dodson will start after July 8th and finish in mid-August 2013.

Traffic Impacts

Starting after July 8th, most of this work will occur at night and there will be no daytime lane closures.

Nighttime Lane and Ramp Closures and Detours: The nighttime lane closures will occur from 6 p.m. to 6 a.m. in both the eastbound and westbound directions. The closures will alternate between the right and left lanes and the open lane will be narrowed.

There will also be ramp closures at exit 35. When the eastbound off-ramp from I-84 is closed, travelers will be directed to exit at Bridal Veil (exit 28) and travel the Historic Highway to Dodson. When the westbound on-ramp is closed, travelers will detour east to the Bonneville exit (40) and to then head westbound on I-84. Travelers can follow signed detours.

Project Benefits

The new driving surface will eliminate ruts and potholes and provide a smoother ride. The overlay of new pavement on the bridge decks will help preserve their structural integrity and reduce the need for future more costly repairs
