Deputies arrested this man after he stole items and fled from the Wood Village Walmart. The man had numerous syringes and needles in his possession. Here, deputies take extra precautions when patting down the subject during the arrest process. Although rare, First Responders have been poked with used needles.

In the past couple of weeks, Corbett area residents have reported at least 7 separate incidents of suspicious persons. On 9/3 at 3:15AM, a citizen on Corbett Hill Rd. reported that a naked man was knocking on his front door, alleging that he had been beaten up and dropped off. Deputies located the man and arrested him on a warrant and for failing to report to his probation officer for his ankle monitoring bracelet. The man would not provide the details of his alleged attackers.

Other citizens have reported various suspicious vehicles, driving up long, remote driveways. In one incident a man in a newer white Corvette was confronted and the license plate was forwarded to the Sheriff's Office. A deputy eventually obtained a phone number and spoke to the man. The man claimed that "vibrations in the air" led him to the remote residence.

It's highly recommended that Citizens call either 911 or the non-emergency# immediately to report these incidents.
