WHAT IS A TIP VOLUNTEER?

TIP Volunteers are called by law enforcement, fire, medical and hospital personnel to respond to scenes of sudden or unexpected death (natural, homicide, suicide, accidental, infant), industrial accidents, sexual assaults, violent crimes and other traumatic incidents to provide immediate emotional and practical support to families, friends, witnesses and victims.

- * Fingerprinting through TIP
- * Attend ALL Training Sessions
- * Valid Driver's License & Vehicle
- * Cell Phone (with Texting)
- * Internet Access
- * GPS Navigation System
- * Three 12-hour Shifts a Month
- * Attend Monthly CE Meeting
